• Use your favorite Internet browser (Chrome, Firefox, Edge, Safari, etc.) and navigate to our community website at <a href="www.paradiseharbornc.com">www.paradiseharbornc.com</a>. Follow instructions at the top right of the home page under the Register menu item. This portal will be the source of a lot of community info. In fact, some links shown in this document will only work if you have a registered owner account.

Gate Codes or Gate Remotes - Please use the community website links (below) or contact POA:

- Owners of new homes and purchasers of existing homes are eligible to get a PH gate access code (format is #nnnn) upon purchasing their property. Resale owners will receive a new access code and the former owners code will be deleted. Remote access FOBs (clickers) can be purchased for \$25.00 each by using the form available on our website. Link to request Gate code and gate FOBs
- Resident's name and phone number will be added to the gate lookup system so visitors can dial you up to gain access. Once they contact you and you decide they are valid, press the 9 key to allow them in.
- For personal & community security, \*\*\* Do not share your access code with others \*\*\*

### Spectrum Bulk Services - Internet & Cable TV:

- New Homes If you haven't already, send a copy of your official Certificate of Occupancy (CO) as an attachment to poa\_board@paradiseharbornc.com. This will be sent to Spectrum so your address is added to the Bulk services list, and you will receive the service discount. You will be alerted when you can call for a service connection. You should also receive a Spectrum Welcome Package when you start to build your home.
- Resale Seller If you are selling your home, you must return all your Spectrum equipment to the local Spectrum Store and cancel your account before moving out.

#### Adherence to Covenants and Architectural Guidelines - a summary:

- Paradise Harbor is governed by its Covenants, Conditions and Restriction (CCR) document that you may remember agreeing to follow at closing. The document exists to help our aesthetic remain attractive to prospective buyers and to help keep our property values competitive. Just a reminder that although we don't go looking for ways to nit-pick residents, we do have a set of policies & rules that we encourage you to get familiar with and follow. We have created an Indexed version of the CCR document that will help you find items more easily. ## Property Owners Association (POA):

The elected Board of Directors (board) manages the day-to-day activities of the Paradise Harbor community on behalf of the membership. Board meetings are usually open to all and are held each month at the Connelly Springs Town Hall. There will usually be a virtual teleconference as well. The time and place for the meetings are announced on the PH website calendar and usually posted on the message board on the Entrance Shack. The Association (POA) holds its annual meeting each October. This is held for the election of Board members, final budget ratification by the membership and possible votes on issues regarding any proposed CCR changes.

#### **Annual Events:**

- Paradise Harbor strives to have community events each calendar year: Most happen at the Marina Park located at the end of East Paradise Harbor Drive, on Lot 204 (see PH Neighborhood map).
  - o New Year's Ever Bonfire announced and planned on the website forum.
  - o Marina Park Spring cleanup Resident volunteers band together to clean up the marina of limbs and debris. Informal social activity will follow.
  - o Summer Boat Picnic (weather permitting) Usually boats, kayaks, jet skis, canoes, etc. meet down Nolden Creek (see PH Neighborhood map) to tie up and share a potluck, boat to boat. Individual mains, sides, desserts, and drinks are brought to share. Water is usually nice and warm in the creek. Date fluctuates so TBA (To Be Announced) it will be posted on the PH Forum (hosted on the website).
  - o Marina Park Summer Concert Series various bands and other entertainment will be scheduled throughout the summer months.
  - o **Fall Picnic or Octoberfest**: Depending on the weather and participation either can occur. Potluck and good times. Usually, a great sunset and possible bonfire. Again, the website will have details.

### Trash pickup:

- To start trash pickup, residents call or visit the Connelly Springs Town Hall. There you will register to get a large bin on wheels. It will be delivered to your home by the Town.
- If the receptacle ever gets damaged call the Town to have a replacement delivered.
- Trash pickup happens every Wednesday morning, usually well before 9:00 AM. So, it is a good idea to have it out the night before (Tuesday evening).
- The Town of Connelly Springs does not offer recycling.
- All refuse, Kitchen waste, glass, aluminum, paper, cardboard all goes in the bin. To recycle you must either DIY or pay for a service.
- Please remember your trash bin must be put away, and be out of view, after the trash pickup on Wednesday morning. If left out for significant periods it is a violation of the CCRs that could result in warnings and eventually fines.

#### o Other solutions:

- Simply Green is a curbside recycling company out of Morganton that can provide their service to anyone in Paradise Harbor. Each homeowner would need to signup individually for their service on their website as this would not be a community service. Pickup would be once every 2 weeks and you would provide your address to determine the day of the week they would pick up. They already have customers in Connelly Springs and Rutherford College so not a problem coming into Paradise Harbor. If you are interested go to their website (simplygreenrecycling.com) and enroll in their service.

Open Fires - on your property (See NC General Statute §106-950 (a) & (a2) for details on exemptions)

Except for small, maintained fires, you are required to obtain a permit before burning anything, including trees, limbs, twigs, and brush, on your property. Visit <a href="NC Forest Service Burn Permits">NC Forest Service Burn Permits</a> to get an online permit before starting to burn. That address is:

- · Outdoor fires pollute the air.
- Smoke is unhealthy to breathe.
- · Recycle or properly dispose of waste.
- You can be fined for illegal burning.

Newspaper, cardboard and other paper products.





Plastic and other synthetic materials.





Paints, household and agricultural chemicals.





Tires and other rubber products.





Asphalt shingles and heavy oils.





Treated or coated wood and other building materials.





Wire.

# Burning is sometimes allowed:

Vegetative materials originating at private residences (not business property) may be burned, if no public pickup is available and you follow DAQ rules and local ordinances. Don't burn on Code Orange, Red, or Purple days and always check your county air quality forecast before burning. For forecasts, visit <a href="www.ncair.org">www.ncair.org</a>. For more information regarding agricultural burning practices, please contact DAQ or NC Department of Agriculture; <a href="www.ncagr.gov">www.ncagr.gov</a>.

## Land Clearers

- Know the law when burning debris from land clearing.
- Recycle or properly dispose of waste.
- You can be fined for illegal burning.





Piles must contain only natural vegetative materials.



Burn piles must be at least 500 feet from occupied buildings/structures.



Plles must be at least 250 feet from any public road when the wind is blowing toward the roadway.



Fires must be started after 8 a.m., and new material can't be added after 6 p.m.



Don't burn on Code Orange, Red or Purple days and always check your county air quality forecast before burning. For forecasts, visit www.ncair.org.



Before burning, check all NC DAQ rules and NC Forest Service rules. To check permit requirements go to www.ncforestservice.gov.



Check your local ordinances for additional restrictions on open burning.

Smoke from open burning pollutes the air and is unhealthy to breathe. Potential health effects include: lung and eye irritation, headaches, dizziness, asthma attacks, coughing and even death.
